Q10a	Variation 1 – The tempo is faster (Allegretto compared to Lento in the theme), the tonality is minor (compared to major in the theme) and the theme is played in the Tenor saxophone (compared to Soprano Saxophone in the theme).										
Q10b	Variation 2 – The tempo is faster (Andante compared to Lento in the theme), the tonality returns to major as in the theme, and the theme is diminished (shorter) and played fugally (using imitation/canon, polyphonic) in all instruments.										
Q10c	Variation 3 – The tempo is similar to the theme, but played majestically, the tonality remains major as in the theme, and the theme returns to the Soprano Saxophone as in the theme (but with ornamentation)
